education, prevention, and treatment strategies. They recognized that these community coalitions play a critical role in helping to carry out the President’s National Drug Strategy because they are in touch with their community and are the first to detect emerging drug trends.

Representatives Sander Levin (D-MI) and Mark Souder (R-IN) shared their firsthand knowledge of local anti-drug efforts and the success possible when community anti-drug coalitions organize multiple sectors in the community to coordinate multiple strategies towards a single, focused goal. The First Lady of Ohio, Mrs. Hope Taft, highlighted how locally-designed, comprehensive strategies are developed to target resources, attention, effort, programs, and activities to actual community needs. Various coalition leaders were also on hand to highlight evidence that community anti-drug coalitions are making strides in lowering drug and alcohol use around the nation.
